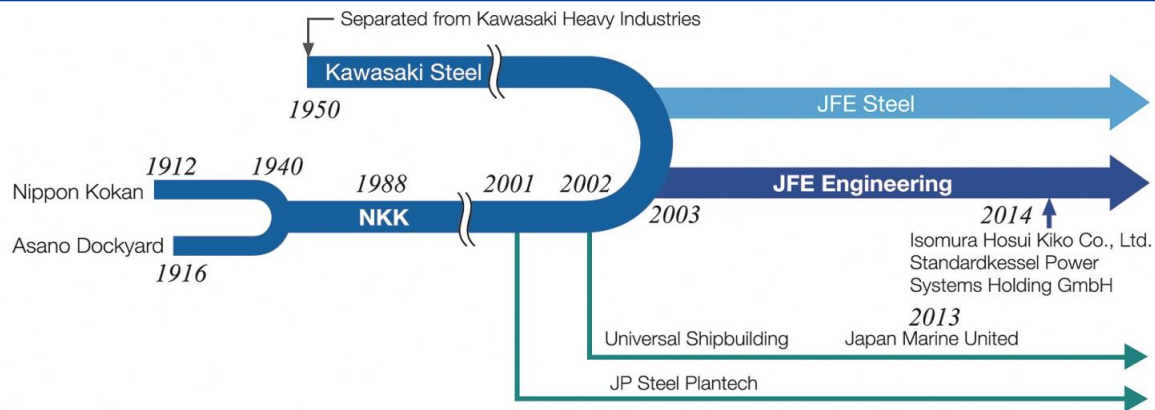


# Creating the Foundation for Life “Ni · na · u”\* the Foundation for Life
