



## Heidelberg | European City of Science



- Heidelberg University founded 1386
- 31 000 students
- 10 000 students in other academic institutions
- University Hospital treats over 1 million patients a year
- 150 000 inhabitants with 21% academics (double the German average)
- 115 000 jobs (2/3 in knowledge-based enterprises)
- Highest child care quota in Western Germany
- 3.5 million visitors a year




#### Technology Park | Linking Science and the Private Sector

Region of Heidelberg has highest quota of "biotech patents" in Germany











- Crime rate is 35% below German average










#### Converting former US-Army Bases
